

Data Privacy Policy - RCPE.at

The protection of your personal data is a special concern to RCPE GmbH. We strictly observe legal provisions and regulations applicable to us when processing your personal data (GDPR, DSG 2018, TKG 2003). We take responsible precautions to prevent unauthorized access to, manipulation, and theft of your data. Within this document, we inform you about the most important aspects of data storage and processing within our website and business activity framework.

Definition of the term: "personal data"

According to GDPR Article 4 lit. 1 "personal data" means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ('data subject'); an identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person.

Duration of storage

RCPE GmbH will store your personal data only for as long as required by legal or contractual deadlines, or as long as necessary to fulfill the respective purpose, or until a withdrawal of consent is transmitted to us.

In contact with us

When you contact us personally, via telephone or email, any data provided by you are stored and processed to answer inquiries, fulfill any requests or provide any services within a potential business relationship. RCPE does not forward this information to any third parties without your consent.

Cookies

Our website uses so-called "cookies". These are small text files that are stored on your end device with the help of your browser. They do not cause any damage. Generally, there are two types of cookies:

- First-party cookies: are created by our website.
- Third-party cookies: are used by other websites (e.g., Matomo).

Additionally, we distinguish between three categories of cookies:

- absolutely necessary cookies to ensure basic website functions,
- functional cookies to ensure the performance of the website, and
- target-oriented or non-necessary cookies to improve the user experience on our website (e.g., analytical cookies).

We use cookies to make our website user-friendly. Cookies help to improve your experience with our website by helping you to continue where you left off and taking your preferences into account.

Some cookies are necessary for our website in order to work for you and be displayed correctly. Other cookies help us to improve your online experience by giving us insights into how the website is used. This information is used to optimize the website for users.

Necessary cookies enable core functionality. The website cannot function properly without these cookies and can only be disabled by changing your browser settings.

Target-oriented cookies such as analytical cookies help us to improve our website by collecting and evaluating information about your usage. You can find out what information is collected under the item "Matomo".

Some cookies remain stored on your end device until you delete them. They allow us to recognize your browser on your next visit. If you do not wish this, you can set up your browser so that it informs you about the settings of cookies and you only allow this in individual cases. Please note that if you disable cookies, the functionality of our website may be limited. Some browsers also support the "private mode" function. This generally deletes cookies from your temporary files automatically, once the browser is closed. Note: not all browsers support this function. Please inform yourself, if your browser has this function and which functionalities your browser supports in "private mode".

You will be asked for your consent to cookies via a "cookie banner" when you open your website. Necessary/functional cookies are selected as standard, as otherwise the website cannot be displayed. For the use of analytical cookies, you must actively give your consent.

Matomo (non-necessary cookie)

For the purpose of efficient web analysis, our website uses the tool "Matomo". For web analysis, usage information, which includes your anonymized IP address, is transferred to our server through "cookies" (see above). This data is not transmitted to any other server (e.g., Matomo). Anonymization means that it is no longer possible to draw conclusions about the user. After anonymization, your usage data is stored on these servers for the purpose of analysis. None of the information or personal data generated by Matomo respectively the cookie is passed on to third parties by Matomo or by us. You must actively consent to the use of Matomo by agreeing to analysis cookies when you access our website.

Purpose of data processing:

The processing of the data serves statistical web usage analysis purposes. These are needed to continuously improve our website and our online presence and to create reports of the activities on our website.

The following information is collected via Matomo and statistically analyzed by us to improve the user experience:

- What country a website visitor is coming from.
- From which website the website visitor comes to our website.
- If the visitor comes from a search engine: which search terms were used to find us.
- The dwell time of the website visitor on our homepage or the individual subpages of the website.



- The movement flows of the website visitors within our website.
- Which of our data is downloaded by the website visitor or which of our videos are viewed.
- Which of the links on our website are clicked.
- Is it a repeated visit or a one-time visit.

Legal Basis of data processing:

The data processing is based on the legal provisions of § 96 para 3 TKG, as well as Art. 6 para 1 lit. f (legitimate interest) of the GDPR. The legitimate interest here relates to conducting an efficient and cost-effective website analysis to improve our website and online presence, as well as the user experience.

If cookies are deactivated, the functionality of our website may be limited.

Social Media

On our website, so-called "social media" icons of companies in the field of "social networks" are in use. The companies concerned are listed below. The use is based on your consent according to TKG § 96 para. 3. You can recognize these social media icons by the respective logos of the companies listed below in the upper right area of our website.

By simply visiting our website, no personal data is transferred to these companies. Only when you "click" on one of the icons personal data will be transferred. This click is considered consent to the data transfer, on the basis of which personal data, such as your IP address, is transferred to the companies. This transmission also takes place if you do not have your own user account with the respective companies.

If you are logged into your account on one of the networks at the time of consent, data can be directly linked to your account and assigned to you. If you do not wish this, you can log out of your account on the respective network on our site before consenting (i.e., before clicking on the icon). We must to point out that we have no influence over the purposes and extent to which the companies listed below collect personal data. Providing information that may be of interest to you

It is our endeavor to present you with information that may be of interest to you and to communicate with you via e-mail. The legal basis for this is Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f (legitimate interest) GDPR and Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a (consent) GDPR.

Our communication with you is based on information that we collected about you and that we may use. We have obtained this information directly through the business card you have provided us with, through existing business relationships, or through an inquiry made by you. For example, we might use the combination of your e-mail address and your first and last name to send you information about services, products, and events offered by RCPE GmbH. The information we collect allows us to indicate internally that you are interested in certain categories of information.

Events

When you contact us through the contact forms on our dedicated event pages, personal data, you provided willingly, is stored and processed to answer inquiries, provide a successful event experience, and fulfill any contractual obligations. Your data will be transferred to accounting service providers. RCPE does not disclose any data to other third parties without your consent or legal basis.

We collect the following data:
First and Last Name
Email Address
Possibly your company/organizational affiliation

After the event's conclusion, your data will be deleted according to any possible legal requirements, unless you have consented to its other use.

Event Notifications

If you subscribe to our company's event notifications, the data in the respective input mask will be transmitted to the data processor. The registration for our event notifications takes



place in a so-called double opt-in procedure, i.e. after registration, you will receive an email to reconfirm your registration. This procedure is necessary to exclude that someone can register with someone else's email addresses. At the time of registration, IP address, date, and time are stored. This enables us to prove registration and consent. A transfer of data to third parties does not take place. An exception exists if there is a legal obligation to pass on the data. The data is used exclusively for sending the event notifications. The subscription to the event notifications can be canceled by the data subject at any time. Likewise, consent to the storage of personal data can be revoked at any time. For this purpose, a corresponding link can be found in each event notification. The legal basis for the processing of the data after registration by the user is the existence of the user's consent Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a) DSGVO.

Use of rapidmail

Description and purpose

We use rapidmail to send event notifications. The provider is rapidmail GmbH, Wentzingerstraße 21, 79106 Freiburg im Breisgau, Germany. Among other things, rapidmail is used to organize and analyze the dispatch of event notifications. The data you enter for

the purpose of receiving the event notifications is stored on rapidmail's servers in Germany. If you do not want any analysis by rapidmail, you must unsubscribe from the event notifications. For this purpose, we provide a corresponding link in every event notification. For the purpose of analysis, the e-mails sent with rapidmail contain a so-called tracking pixel, which connects to the servers of rapidmail when the e-mail is opened. In this way, it can be determined whether a notification has been opened. Furthermore, with the help of rapidmail, we can determine whether and which links in the notifications message are clicked. All links in the e-mail are so-called tracking links, with which your clicks can be counted.

Legal Basis

The legal basis for the data processing is consent according to Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a) GDPR. You can revoke this consent with effect for the future at any time.

Recipients

The recipient of the data is rapidmail GmbH and RCPE GmbH.

Transmission to third countries

There is no transmission of data to third countries.

Duration:

The data stored by us within the scope of your consent for the purpose of the event notifications will be stored by us until you unsubscribe from the notifications and will be deleted from our servers as well as from the servers of rapidmail after you unsubscribe from the event notifications.

Possibility of revocation

You have the possibility to revoke your consent to data processing with effect for the future at any time. The legality of the data processing operations already carried out remains unaffected by the revocation.

Contractual or legal obligation for the provision of personal data

The provision of personal data is neither legally nor contractually required, nor is it necessary for the conclusion of a contract. You are also not obliged to provide personal data. However, failure to provide it would possibly result in you not being able to use this function or not being able to use it to its full extent.

Your Rights as a Data Subject

You have the right to access (Art. 15. GDPR), rectification (Art. 16 GDPR), deletion (Art. 17 GDPR), restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR), and data portability (Art. 20 GDPR). complaint with a supervisory authority, in particular in the Member State of your habitual residence, place of work or of an alleged infringement, in accordance with Art. 77 GDPR.
